E-Safety Training

Autumn 2011 and Spring 2012

In partnership with Dorset Police Safe Schools and Communities Team, Bournemouth Borough Council and Borough of Poole Council we are pleased to be able to offer a series of training events in Internet Safety targeted at Practitioners who work directly with children and young people and their Operational Managers.

About the course

This course aims to provide an in-depth understanding of internet safety for professionals who work with children and young people.

What will I learn?

By the end of the course participants will understand:

- The risks and benefits of the internet
- New trends online
- How young people typically use the internet
- The threat faced by young people from grooming
- What the term 'sexting' means
- Best practice when communicating with young people using technology
- Best practice regarding recording and posting images of young people
- The susceptibility of young people to extreme views online
- The risk to professionals when using social networking sites
- How to keep themselves safer online

Participants will also review a selection of internet safety case studies from across the pan-Dorset area that have been dealt with by the Safe Schools and Communities Team, as well as participating in a practical session on social networking privacy settings.

Duration

3 ½ hours

Target Audience

Professionals and their operational managers from all agencies and organisations within the LSCB partnership who come into contact with children and young people.

Venue

The course is being run on 6 occasions, 3 times in Bournemouth and 3 in Poole. See below for details.

Cost

This training is provided free of charge. We are grateful to SSCT for providing the training and to the Borough Councils for providing the venues.

However, please note:

- We are not able to make refreshments available at these events, so delegates may choose to bring their own drinks and/or snacks.
- There will be a charge of £30 for delegates that book onto the course and then fail to attend or who cancel later than one week prior to the training date.
